- Monthly lesson fees are due at the first lesson of the month.
- Course tuition is to be paid prior to the first class session.
- Kindly provide ample notice of any expected absences.
- With at least 24 hours notice, make-up lessons may be scheduled at our mutual convenience.
- Late cancellations will not be made-up, but the courtesy of a phone call is expected.
- Group lesson / ensemble absences will not be made-up.
- No refunds, except in cases of illness, injury or relocation that prevents continuation of lessons.
